





THE GARAGE

For making this garage you will need:

• a larger cardboard box (top level). The box shown below is 38 cm high, 49 cm wide and 35 cm deep.





How to make the cardboard garage shown here



Draw a line along one of the longer sides of the box, then cut it as shown below.




Fold the cut side into the box, creating the ramp.




Fasten the longer side over the shorter sides with the double-sided tape.



Cut an opening into the side of the box as shown, then place the garage sign above it.



Tape the bottom sides together but leave the sides free.



Turn the box on its side and draw three lines, then cut along them as shown below.



- Push the cut edge into the box.
- Cut it to the same size as the ramp, then stick them together using double-sided tape.



Tape the sides of the smaller box as shown, leaving one side free. Stick the garage door on the longer side and cut around it, so the door can open.


Turn the box around and cut a large opening on the other side.




Fasten the two boxes together with the double-sided tape, then tape the free sides to the boxes as shown.



Stick the car wash labels and the red arrows on cardboard, then cut them out. Leave some room under the arrows for the tape.



Use a leftover piece of cardboard from the larger box to create another ramp. Attach it to the garage using double-sided tape. Add the arrows as shown.
